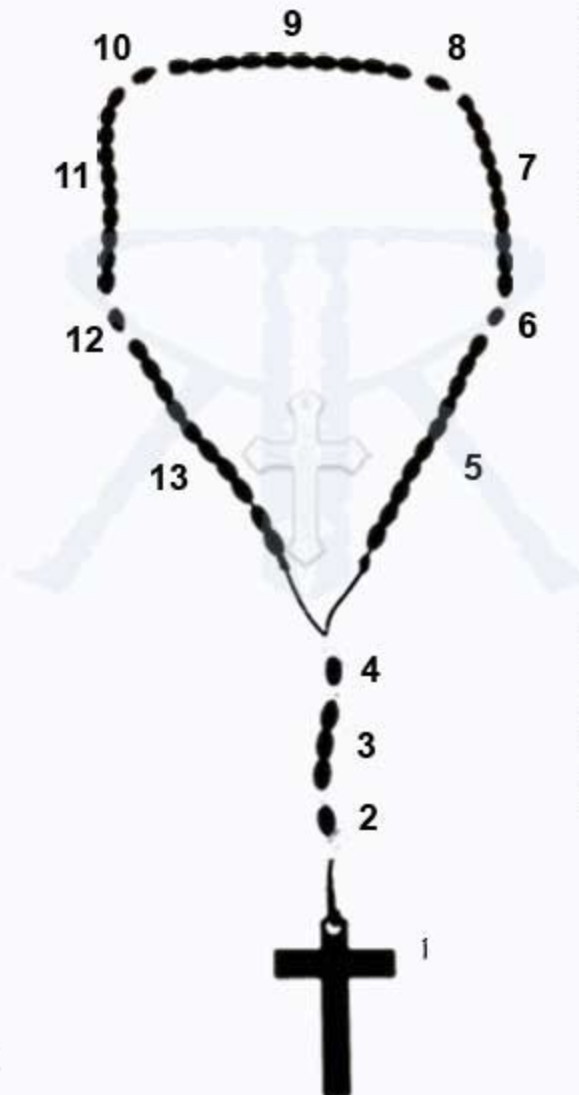


How To Pray The Rosary

6. Say the 'Glory Be' then 'Fatima' prayer. Next announce the 2nd mystery and say the 'Our Father' prayer
7. Say 10 'Hail Mary' prayers while meditating on the mystery
8. Say the 'Glory Be' then 'Fatima' prayer. Next announce the 3rd mystery and say the 'Our Father' prayer
9. Say 10 'Hail Mary' prayers while meditating on the mystery
10. Say the 'Glory Be' then 'Fatima' prayer. Next announce the 4th mystery and say the 'Our Father' prayer
11. Say 10 'Hail Mary' prayers while meditating on the mystery
12. Say the 'Glory Be' then 'Fatima' prayer. Next announce the 5th mystery and say the 'Our Father' prayer
13. Say 10 'Hail Mary' prayers while meditating on the mystery.
 - Say the 'Glory Be' prayer
 - Say the 'Fatima' prayer
 - Say the 'Hail Holy Queen' prayer
 - Say the 'Let Us Pray' prayer
 - Say the 'Intention Of Our Holy Father' prayer
 - (1-'Our Father', 1-'Hail Mary', 1-'Glory Be')
 - Make the sign of the cross
